

English Immersion courses and camps

DATES:

Course dates

LOCATION:

Various locations throughout central Spain (all camps are outside Madrid)
All camps take place in residencies (youth hostels, Halls of residencies etc)

STUDENTS:

Young learners/teenagers.

12 – 14 year olds.

15 to 17 year olds.

BOARD AND LODGINGS:

All board and lodgings provided in the university residence. Teachers should take their own towels and personal hygiene requirements (soap, shampoo etc)

SALARY:

€350 gross per week.
Salary deductions corresponding to taxation and social security contributions are made in accordance with Spanish law based on a sliding scale of earnings. At present, deductions are approximately as follows:

2 % I.R.P.F. (tax)
6.4 % Social Security
8.4 % Total

TRAVEL EXPENSES:

Return travel to the camp from Madrid (The beginning and end of the camp) provided by Berlitz.

CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

- Candidate MUST be:
- Native English (non-EU passport holders must have a valid Spanish work permit) or Bilingual speakers
- University graduate or have recognized teaching qualification (TEFL, CELTA, PGCE etc)
- At least 21 years of age
- Prepared to interact with students both in and outside the classroom.

WORKING DAY:

The course is based on an immersion program. Students will have from 4 to 6 hours of class per day in groups plus afternoon/evening activities (in the form of quizzes, games, debates, etc, some of which will be prepared for in the earlier classes)
Sports will also form part of the daily schedule.
The students will be in constant contact with the teachers (Including meal times and social times)
